Help celebrate the National Park Service's 100th anniversary with a quilt block!

Your quilt block(s) should represent something about a National Park Service property and/or what it means to you. Remember – National Park Service properties include:

National Historic Sites
National Seashores
National Lakeshores

National Battlefield Parks
National Monuments
National Scenic Trails

(Wisconsin's NPS properties: Apostle Islands National Lakeshore; Ice Age National Scenic Trail; St. Croix National Scenic River)

You might use a block pattern that says 'national parks' to you, or select fabrics to represent features of Park Service properties – animals or flowers, history, scenery, buildings, etc.

Or perhaps you'd like to try your hand at a small landscape vignette. Select a photo to recreate on your quilt block, then choose fabrics and fussy cut them to create your scene. Use a glue stick to place them on a background square and sew around the edges when you have the scene the way you want it.
