

Magic Christmas Stocking

Two fat quarters or 2 regular quarters . If directional fabric you'll need 13".

Place pattern on the fabric carefully as you will need 13 1/4" x 5" piece for cuff.

Cut 2 outside fabric

Cut 2 lining fabric

Cut 2 thin batting

Cut one cuff piece from both fabrics. 13 1/4" x 5".

Layer stocking:

2 pieces of stocking fabric (RST)

1 single layer of batting

2 pieces of lining fabric (RST)

1 single layer of batting

Pin every inch around the stocking leaving the top edge open. Sew 1/4" seam.

Shorten stitch length and check tension. You may need to tighten it.

Clip the curves.

*Reach into opening between the two lining pieces and pull out.

*Reach into opening between the two stocking pieces and pull out.

You will have stocking, lined, with seams enclosed, and raw edges on top.

Place a "hanging loop" at the top inside edge of stocking with the loop part facing down into the heel of the stocking. Pin loop next to the seam allowance to reduce bulk. Use cording, ribbon, matching loop from fabrics, selvage edge of a fabric. For self-fabric loop, cut 1 1/2" x 6", fold twice and topstitch. Trim to 5".

Sew the two cuff fabrics along the long edge RST and press seam open. (This is where you would add rick-rack, piping, beads, lace if you wish.)

Sew the short edges together RST. Now fold in half WST matching raw edges making a tube that has 2 different fabric sides. Either fabric may be chosen to show for the outside cuff of stocking. Press.

Slip the cuff inside the stocking, matching the raw edges and s.a. The fabric that you want to show on the outside should be facing the lining. Pin well and sew around the top edge.

Flip the cuff from the inside to the outside . Finger press and embellish if you wish.
